

INFORMATIONS FOR CARS & MOTORBIKES

Limassol – Piraeus

Procedure for loading vehicles / required documents

1. The vehicle must be accompanied by the owner.
2. If this is not possible, it must be a driver only A first degree relative or spouses with the necessary authorization from the owner and certified by a certifying employee.
3. If the car is co-owned then authorization from the co-owner is required.
4. If the vehicle is on finance, approval from the bank must be provided.
5. Gas-powered modified vehicles and electric vehicles are prohibited.
6. The 3 categories of vehicles/title deeds are
 - Cypriot vehicles
 - Other European Union vehicles
 - Third-country vehicles

Cypriot vehicles

- Registration certificate (Title deed / Logbook)
- ID / Passport
- Valid road taxes

Other European Union vehicles

- Registration certificate (Title deeds / Logbook)
- ID / Passport
- Import documents (Delivery Order or original C1040 form)

Third-country vehicles

- Registration certificate (Title deeds / Logbook)
- ID / Passport
- Import documents (Delivery Order or original C1040 form)

**Please have all the above documents in their original form with you when boarding/disembarking as there will be a customs document check.*

***Failure to send the documents in legible form at least four (4) days before the departure/arrival of the vehicle could cause the delay or cancellation of the exportation/importation of your vehicle.*

Piraeus – Limassol

Procedure for loading the vehicles / required documents

1. The vehicle must be accompanied by the owner.
2. If this is not possible, it must be a driver only A first degree relative or spouses with the necessary authorization from the owner and certified by a certifying employee.
3. If the car is co-owned then authorization from the co-owner is required.
4. If the vehicle is on finance, approval from the bank must be provided.
5. Gas-powered modified vehicles and electric vehicles are prohibited.
6. The 3 categories of vehicles/title deeds are
 - Cypriot vehicles
 - Other European Union vehicles
 - Third-country vehicles

Cypriot vehicles

- Registration certificate (Title deeds / Logbook)
- ID / Passport

Other European Union vehicles

- Ownership certificate
- ID / Passport
- Driver's license

(It is noted that, in some cases, the certificate of proof of EU status will not be limited to the presentation of the vehicle's registration certificate and plates, but should be extended to other proofs, especially for right-hand drive vehicles transported and registered from countries with left-hand drive system. These cases will require further investigation by customs.)

Third country vehicles

- Original Registration Certificate (Title deeds / Logbook)
- Passport
- Driver's license
- Completing the attached document "Temporary Admission TEA - 1A"
- Valid insurance document in Cyprus.

In cases of a green card, only the following countries can be accepted: AUSTRIA, BELGIUM, BULGARIA, CYPRUS, CZECH REPUBLIC, GERMANY, DENMARK, SPAIN, ESTONIA, FRANCE, FINLAND, GREECE, HUNGARY, CROATIA, ITALY, IRELAND, LUXEMBOURG, LITHUANIA, LATVIA, MALTA, NETHERLANDS, PORTUGAL, POLAND, ROMANIA, SWEDEN, SLOVAKIA, SLOVENIA, SWITZERLAND / ICELAND, NORWAY, ANDORA, BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA, MONTENEGRO, SERBIA, UNITED KINGDOM, ALBANIA, AZERBAIJAN, MOROCCO, MOLDOVA, NORTH MACEDONIA, TUNISIA, TURKEY, UKRAINE.

*Please have all the above documents in their original form with you when boarding/disembarking as there will be a customs document check.

***Failure to send the documents in legible form at least four (4) days before the departure/arrival of the vehicle could cause the delay or cancellation of the exportation/importation of your vehicle.*
